

Volunteer Application

Thank you for your interest in volunteering at the Dorothy H. O'Connor Pet Adoption Center (DOCPAC). Our volunteers are an integral asset to the shelter, assisting with the pets' daily care and socialization skills.

Prior to volunteering at the shelter, you will need to attend our Volunteer Orientation Class. Orientation is typically held the first Saturday of each month. *Space is limited.* **Call us at 361-575-8573 or email volunteers@docpac.net to reserve your orientation class spot.**

How can I be a volunteer?

1. Volunteers must be at least 10 years of age. Ages 10-15 must be always accompanied by an adult while they volunteer. The adult(s) that will be accompanying the child must take the orientation as well. A strict ratio of one adult to every two minors will be enforced.
2. Submit a completed Volunteer Application
3. Pay the one-time administrative fee of \$25.00 which helps us cover the cost of your t-shirt and orientation materials. Fees are non-refundable. If you are supervising a child, the fee is waived, and a t-shirt can be purchased separately. (*Fee is collected on the day you attend orientation*)
4. Please wear appropriate, comfortable clothing and tennis shoes. (No flip flops)

Must I commit to a minimum number of monthly hours to be eligible to volunteer at the Shelter?

No. You can volunteer as much or as little as you like.

Can I bring home diseases or infections to my pets?

Volunteers never work directly with animals that may be ill with a transmittable illness.

However, we still recommend using common sense sanitary measures, and ensuring your own pets are up to date on vaccinations.

Will I get bitten or scratched?

There is always the possibility that a scratch or bite may occur. Following our procedures for proper handling will help to minimize this possibility. *Any bites, scratches, or other injury must be reported to staff immediately.*
